### Canterbury Potters' Association 45th Annual Exhibition 2018

### Terms and condition of entry:

**Eligibility:** Financial members for 2018-19 year only are able to enter. All entrants are asked to do **two** duties on the roster. Please add your name to the roster when you deliver your work.

Awards: The Selector will determine award winners. First time ever exhibitors in any exhibition are eligible for selection for the Avice Hill Memorial Prize. The Avice Hill Memorial prize for the first time exhibitor will be determined by the President of the CPA and the selector. The Selector's decision will be final. No correspondence will be entered into. Awards will be announced and presented at the exhibition opening Wednesday 14 November, 6 pm.

**Entries:** Entries must be the sole work of the entrant. Entries must not have been exhibited in any previous exhibitions. Entrants can enter <u>six entries</u>, one of which may be a set (three or more pieces). A pair is considered to be one entry. Late entries will not be accepted. All entries must be for sale.

**Entry form and fees:** Entrants must complete sections A and B of the entry form (in full) and enclose the entry fee of \$30.00. Cheques to be made out to Canterbury Potters Association.

**Commission:** CPA will charge commission of 33 1/3% of the retail price on all sales.

**Packaging:** Each piece must have a sticker on its base with your name, price and a number to correspond with the number on your entry from. Work must be packed securely for safe transit to the museum. Insecure packages will not be accepted. Packing boxes should be clearly labelled named on all sides. Packing material should be clean, no shredded paper.

**Insurance:** Entrants are responsible for the insurance of their work while in transit and throughout the duration of the exhibition at the museum.

**Receiving:** Receiving date is Thursday 11 October at Canterbury Potters 395 Memorial Avenue between 11am-1pm and 6-8 pm. Any enquiries to Convenor, by email canterburypotters@gmail.com

**Photography:** The organisers reserve the right to photograph and reproduce selected work in the newsletter, website or for other publicity purposes relating to the exhibition.
