To celebrate our 50th exhibition, entries are invited from all active members. There will be no selection this year, and all entries submitted will be exhibited.

### **Awards:**

Four awards will be announced and presented at the exhibition opening.

- Avice Hill Memorial Prize for a first-time ever exhibitor selected by the exhibition convenor/s.
- Handbuilding Award selected by Margaret Ryley (Life Member).
- Throwing Award selected by Frederika Ernten (Life Member).
- Premier Award selected by the convenor/s and life members.

People's Choice Award will be voted for by public, and announced after the exhibition.

### **Terms and Conditions:**

- Only financial members for the 2023-24 year may enter.
- Entrants can enter two pieces OR one pair.
- You are asked to do two exhibition duties. Add your name to the roster on Receiving Day.
- Entries must be the sole work of the entrant, and must not have been exhibited previously.
- Late entries will not be accepted.
- All entries must be for sale.
- CPA/Museum will charge a commission of 33 1/3% of the retail price on all sales.
- Entrants are responsible for insuring their work while in transit and for the duration of the exhibition.

### **Receiving:**

- Entries must be accompanied by a completed entry form (on reverse).
- Entrants must pay \$25.00 (GST-inclusive) on receiving day by online transfer (ref Exhibn) or cash.
- Each piece must have a sticker on its base with your name, price and the number on your entry form.
- Work must be packed securely for safe transit. Boxes should be clearly named on all sides. Packing material should be clean (no shredded paper). Insecure packages will not be accepted.
